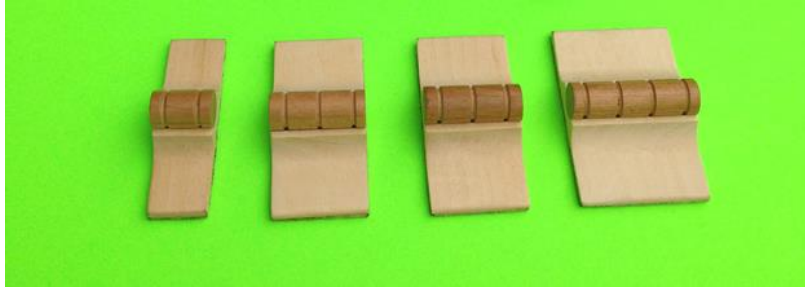


# String Jack



- ♪ The String Jack is for the adventurous guitarist who wants to explore a different way to bend strings on the guitar.
- ♪ It's like bending the strings behind the nut but moved onto the fretboard.
- ♪ Simply position a String Jack under the strings and find a tuning.
- ♪ To bend a note, press down on a string until it touches the fingerboard and use the frets as a reference.



# Notes behind the String Jack

♪ The area behind the String Jack is another place for the string to vibrate. Depending on where the String Jack is positioned, any interval can be formed.

♪ Place the edge of the Interval Guide next to the fretboard. The dashed lines indicate where to place the center of a String Jack.
